# Message from Admin


Hello Our Lady of Victories families!

May is filled with fun and special activities, including our Living Rosary, Spring Concert, and field trips. We look forward to celebrating these events with our families!


As May is the month of Mary, we ask for the blessing of our caregivers this month, and to keep all the mothers in our school community in our prayers.

# School Spirit Theme Days


Our Student Leadership Team has planned some fun school spirit theme days to align with our Friday Fun Lunch dates. All staff and students are invited and encouraged to participate!


## Affiliated Parish
